The cancer is in the lining of the abdomen(which kind of holds all the organs in their place) and not specifically the stomach. It is believed at this time that it started in the appendix area and maybe/or colon on the right side. This was diagnosed in Tyler from a CAT Scan and biopsies . Tyler has recommended a confirmation of the diagnosis be done at MD Anderson and so we wait for their call by Tuesday. If Houston agrees when we get there with the diagnosis, what surgery that needs to be done (which at least will be colon and appendix) they will do in Houston and set the chemo up to be flushed in the abdomen straight and a port set up if it looks as though more chemo will be needed at a later date to be done maybe here at Tyler.

Prayers are certainly appreciated and needed. I feel really good right now so that is a blessing. Lon is an excellent care taker and he needs your prayers as well. God is always good!
