

Summer Programs

Start Strong Program

W. G. Sanders Middle School is offering a four-week **Start Strong Summer Program** for rising 6th – 9th graders. This program is designed to provide students with literacy and numeracy strategies that will help support their learning when they return to school in the fall. During the program, students will participate in engaging activities and have opportunities to receive incentives. Students will be assessed to determine their progress on content and skills learned in the summer program. There is **no cost** to attend the Start Strong Summer Program.

Summer Soar Recovery Credit Program

Summer Soar Montessori Program

The Montessori Summer Intensive is a four-week program that focuses on analytical writing, science, financial literacy, social justice seminars, art projects, and math prep for the upcoming school year. Students will also learn how to use their agendas, get experience using Teams and Class Notebook, and learn how to use the Montessori work-plans, manage deadlines, and get into the flow of being in the Montessori environment. This summer program is for rising 6th – 8th grade students who have been accepted to the WG Sanders Montessori Middle Level Program; students who are new to the program; students who are in need of additional support, or students who are moving into Algebra I for the 2021-2022 school year. Career Magnet Summer Enrichment Program

This is a three-week program that will focus on reading, writing, math and soft skills through an interdisciplinary PBL units of study. The PBL units of study will be based on core content integrated with selected CATE standards that align to the MSAP grant expectations. Students will explore leadership through four different career pathways, create mock business, and develop media skills.
