
Michael Obermeyer, Oil Painter - April Demo



A native of Southern California, Michael Obermeyer received a Bachelor of Fine Arts in Illustration at California State University, Long Beach. A twenty year career in illustration included works for Disney Studios, the Anaheim Angels, McDonnell Douglas, Coldwell Banker, and the United States Air Force. Because of his illustration background, he is equally comfortable with the landscape and the figure. Many of his paintings are in the U.S. Air Force Historical Art Collection in the Smithsonian Institute and the Pentagon.

He recently won the "Collector's Choice Award" and the Southwest Magazine "Quick Draw" Award at the Laguna Beach Invitational Plein Air Competition, as well as the "Best of Show" at the Grand Canyon Celebration of Art, and the Gold Medal at the Carmel Art Festival. Collectors include the Marriott Hotels and Resorts, The Irvine Company, Hoag Hospital, California State Parks and many corporate as well as private commissions. Michael is a member of the Oil Painters of America, The Society of Illustrators, and a Signature Member of the California Art Club and the Laguna Plein Air Painters Association.

Currently, his paintings are showing at galleries in Carmel, Sonoma, Claremont and Laguna Beach, where he is also a regular exhibitor at the Festival of Arts. He maintains his studio in Laguna Beach, California.

To opening Gallery Hosts, I am making a slight change to the opening procedure. Call the next day's Gallery Hosts then call me at 760-295-7635 and if you do not reach me then call 760-672-5990.

Coal will be having another Village Faire Art Festival the weekend of June 6th and 7th. Last years participating artists will have the highest priority. The spaces that are left will then be on a first come first serve basis, with members having the higher priority. The festival will run from 10 am to 4 pm on both days and storage will be provided at COAL gallery on Saturday night. The arrival time will be 9 am.

The fee will be \$20 for members or \$25 for non-members or a single day fee of \$10. Parking passed will be available both days for the employees lot, across Grand Ave.

One of the great things about this sale is there will be no gallery commission, unless you process the sale on the gallery credit card machine. If processed on the machine the sale will be treated as a normal gallery sale.


